

Let Us Pray Wk. 5 The Prayer of Moses

We can experience deep, personal prayer with God by following the pattern of the Tabernacle — a journey of thanksgiving, repentance, worship, and intimacy.

Journey into God's Presence

Outer Court: Thanksgiving & Praise

⁴ Enter his gates with thanksgiving; go into his courts with praise. Give thanks to him and praise his name. ⁵ For the Lord is good. His unfailing love continues forever, and his faithfulness continues to each generation."

Psalm 100:4-5 (NLT)

- Begin prayer by thanking God.
- Gratitude centres us and prepares our hearts.

Prayer

"Thank you, God, for my health, my friends, and your love!"

Brazen Altar: Remember the Cross

⁶ When we were utterly helpless, Christ came at just the right time and died for us sinners."

Romans 5:6 (NLT)

⁵ But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed."

Isaiah 53:5 (NIV)

- Jesus is our ultimate sacrifice
- Transgressions = Reflect what we have done, how we have behaved
- Iniquities = Refer to who we are, the condition of our heart
- Reflect on His wounds and what they mean for you.

Prayer

"Jesus, thank you for dying for my sins. Forgive me and transform my heart."

The Laver: Clean Hearts, Surrendered Body

“¹ And so, dear siblings I plead with you to give your bodies to God because of all he has done for you. Let them be a living and holy sacrifice—the kind he will find acceptable. This is truly the way to worship him.”

Romans 12:1 (NLT)

- Ask God to reveal sin or anything displeasing.
- Surrender your whole self to God.

Prayer

“Lord, search my heart and renew my mind.”

Candlestick: Life in the Holy Spirit

“⁶ This is why I remind you to fan into flames the spiritual gift God gave you when I laid my hands on you. ⁷ For God has not given us a spirit of fear and timidity, but of power, love, and self-discipline.”

2 Timothy 1:6–7 (NLT)

- Invite the Holy Spirit to guide and empower you.
- Fan into flames the gifts God has given to you.

Prayer

“Holy Spirit, fill me. Use my gifts to serve and glorify you.”

Table of Showbread: Feeding on God's Word

“⁴ But Jesus told him, “No! The Scriptures say, ‘People do not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God.’”


Matthew 4:4 (NLT)

“¹² For the word of God is alive and powerful. It is sharper than the sharpest two-edged sword, cutting between soul and spirit, between joint and marrow. It exposes our innermost thoughts and desires.”

Hebrews 4:12 (NLT)

“¹¹ Put on all of God's armor so that you will be able to stand firm against all strategies of the devil.”

Ephesians 6:11 (NLT)



- God's Word gives strength, truth, and clarity.
- The Word equips us to defend ourselves

Prayer

"Jesus, you are my daily bread. Teach me through your Word."

Altar of Incense: Worship & Intercession

"⁶ Come, let us worship and bow down. Let us kneel before the Lord our maker, ⁷ for he is our God. We are the people he watches over, the flock under his care. If only you would listen to his voice today!"

Psalm 95:6–7 (NLT)

- Worship God who cares for and watches over you.
- Pray for others and the world.

Prayer

"God, you are worthy of all my worship. I pray Lord for my family, my friends, and my school."

Ark of the Covenant: God's Presence & Mercy

"¹ A shoot will come up from the stump of Jesse; from his roots a Branch will bear fruit. ² The Spirit of the Lord will rest on him— the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of power, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord— ³ and he will delight in the fear of the Lord."

Isaiah 11:1 (NLT)

"¹⁰ In that day the Root of Jesse will stand as a banner for the peoples; the nations will rally to him, and his place of rest will be glorious."

Isaiah 11:10 (NLT)

"⁵¹ At that moment [what moment? The moment Jesus died. At that moment] the curtain in the sanctuary of the Temple was torn in two, from top to bottom. The earth shook, rocks split apart."

Matthew 27:51 (NLT)

- Enter God's presence.
- Receive His grace, promises, and forgiveness.

Prayer

"Father, thank you for your mercy and nearness. I rest in you." I will come boldly to your throne of grace.
